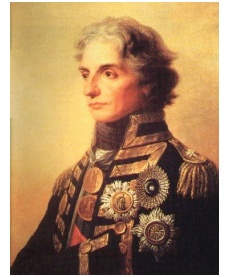
To celebrate Nelson's first great victory in 1797, The Nelson Society returns to The Union Jack Club for this ever-popular fixture.

He joined the RNR in 1986 as Lieutenant and was promoted to Lieutenant Commander in 1994. In 2006 he was awarded the Reserve Decoration I and is still actively involved in the RNR.
